NEW RC DRILLING PROGRAM COMMENCES AT GIDGEE

Legend Mining Limited wishes to announce the commencement of a further phase of exploration drilling at Gidgee. A 25 hole reverse circulation ("RC") drilling program commenced at the Gidgee Mine Area on 19 November and is expected to be completed by 20 December 2005. Assay results are expected to be available from mid-December to early January 2006.

Targets to be tested during the current drilling campaign include:

- extensions to mineralised structures identified from Legend's 2005 RC drilling,
- new conceptual targets, including high grade north-west trending cross structures, postulated from a recent reappraisal of previous drilling in the Mine Area, and
- areas containing highly anomalous results from Legend's 2005 aircore drilling program.

The geological modeling and wire-framing of mineralisation discovered as a result of the 2005 drilling is underway, and Legend expects to have preliminary resource estimates available for the Mine Area by end December 2005.
