## COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

- The 2 sqm rule will be observed
- AHA COVID Hygiene Officers will be onsite for the duration of the event
- All delegates must provide a **direct** email address & mobile number when registering, should this information be required by the Hotel or Health Department. This information will only be disclosed if requested
- Hand sanitiser and masks will be available for delegates in various locations
- Regular high touch cleaning will be undertaken during the conference
- The auditorium in the Hyatt Ballroom can seat 1,000 delegates, but with social distancing, seating will be limited to 300
- Separate entry and exits will be clearly marked for both auditorium and exhibition area
- The exhibition area is in a secure outside area, allowing free air flow
- We are making available trestle tables, 76cm wide, for social distancing between those working in a booth and delegates – think Bunnings
- Red squares in the exhibition area will be a guide for delegates to use the centre of aisles for movement
- Delegates will receive meal vouchers with name badges as food can no longer be served from a buffet
  - Each meal session will be broken into two serving times as indicated on the voucher
  - A blackboard will list the day's food selection for easy choice and minimal contact and queuing
  - Meals will be in sealed boxes and handed to delegates by hotel staff on receipt of the voucher
  - Drinks (soft drinks for lunch and bottled water) will be provided in recyclable containers
